General Club Rules for Race Days

- 1) Riders must sign-on and attend "riders briefing" within the required time.
- 2) All motorcycles must undergo **scrutineering** before being allowed into pit area.
- 3) Every entrant must be a **financial member** of the Griffith Motorcycle Sports Club Inc or a member of an invited Affiliated Club.
- 4) All entrants must hold an **MA license**.
- 5) If entrant is unlicensed, a "**ONE-DAY**" license must be obtained for the day from the Race Secretary on the day. The cost is \$50.00 (**Maximum of 2 Day licences per year**)
- 6) All riders will be required to pass a riding test before being able to apply for a new license or purchase a day license.
- 7) Individual classes for the club championship will be :

Juniors	Seniors
Mini Bikes 50cc	Under 205cc
Junior Trail Bike	2 stroke Open Class
65cc Mx Bike	4 stroke Open Class
85cc Mx Bike	"A" Grade Open Class
125cc	"B" Grade Open Class
	Over 35yr "Grey Hair"
	Open 4 wheelers

- 8) The club may combine classes if insufficient numbers are entered. A class must have at least 4 entries to constitute a class. If insufficient entries to constitute a class no class will be contested on the day.
- 9) No riding of motorcycles in Spectator or Car Park areas. When loading and unloading, motorcycles must be pushed not ridden.
- 10) No riding of motorcycles in Pit Area.
- 11) No children under the age of 16 years permitted in Pit Area unless they are a competitor on the day.
- 12) **No alcohol or smoking allowed in the Pit Area.**
- 13) All motorcycles must be fitted with an effective muffler to ensure no undue noise.
- 14) All bikes must have riding numbers displayed.
- 15) Rear nobby tyres are not permitted on the Flat Track except on 50cc mini bikes and 80cc trail bikes.
- 16) Due to restrictions placed on the club by the Environmental Protection Authority the track can only be used between the times of 10:00am and 6:00pm.
- 17) Rubbish must be placed in the bins provided and the area left tidy.
- 18) Offensive behavior and language towards **fellow riders and officials** will not be tolerated. Any behavior of this nature could lead to suspension of riding licence and Club membership
- 19) **When no committee members present the caretaker will be in charge and all members and spectators must obey any instructions given.**
- 20) All other rules will be as per the General Competition Rules and Starting Out in Motorcycle Sport booklet published by Motorcycling Australia.
- 21) ***The same rules apply for practice days!***
